## **SOWING HOPE**

"I did not grow up in a culture where women went to school. We got married and depended on our husbands to put food on the table. I didn't know where to start, but I knew I needed to do something," she recalls." I worked as a classroom assistant and private tutor during the school year and as a camp director during the summers. At the beginning, I walked everywhere or depended on others for transportation. Once I got a car, I also began delivering pizzas.

Life's challenges continued when my middle daughter was diagnosed with Essential Thrombocythemia (a myropelifitive disorder affecting her platelets). She is now stable in her

platelet count; needing the specialist only twice a year. Later, my son briefly battled and conquered depression. My little family has had its share of highs and lows, but we have overcome together."

Amy was one day away from admittance to a local homeless shelter. The paperwork was in order.

"This is not where I EVER expected to be," she explained when I met her.

Amy is a real estate agent. Her car is decent. Her business suit and mannerisms professional. Like so many other women, She's a working single mom, struggling to make ends meet. "When the two home sales I was counting on to pay my bills this month fell through, I had nowhere to turn. Every other agency said I needed an eviction notice before they could do anything."

After hearing Amy's story, the Relevant Life Solutions team, in partnership with the Orange Cove SDA Church and an anonymous donor, felt God's quiet nudge. We paid her rent. "Thank you so much!" She hugged me. Hard. "Now my kids can finish the school year with their class. This means so much to us!"
